**Biographical Note:** Dr. John Allen Dicks Cooper was born on December 22, 1918 in El Paso, Texas. He grew up in the bilingual and bicultural environment of Las Cruces, New Mexico and attended the New Mexico State University from which he graduated with his B.S. degree in Chemistry in 1939. His interest in science and friendship with Dr. Robert J. McBride, a Las Cruces practitioner, were instrumental in his decision to pursue further education in the sciences. Dr. Cooper said, "Financially I wasn't able to go to medical school. But fellowships for graduate work were offered by a number of schools and I chose Northwestern." In 1943, he earned his Ph.D. in biochemistry. Dr. Cooper continued at Northwestern and served as a Biochemistry instructor there from 1943-1947 and as an assistant professor from 1947-1951. In 1951, he earned his M.D. from Northwestern.

This bilingual, bicultural background led to international involvement in the medical field; and for four months in 1956, Dr. Cooper lived in Brazil where he taught the first courses for medical doctors in radioisotopes and biology. Two years later, he lived in Argentina for four months and once again taught physicians about radioisotopes and biology. Cooper was single-handedly responsible for training most of the Latin doctors in these areas of medicine. Dr. Gabriel Velazquez-Palau, who was a visiting professor of social medicine at Harvard Medical School, once introduced Dr. Cooper as "the only Anglo-American Latin" he had ever met. Dr. Cooper pushed for forming a federation of medical colleges in South America. Although the idea was initially rejected, the Pan American Federation of Associations of Medical Schools (PAFAMS) was later formed and had a substantial effect on medical education. Dr. Cooper was on the board of PAFAMS from 1963-1976.

He also had a strong sense of service to both the medical community and the wider community it served. Dr. Cooper was an associate dean of the Northwestern Medical School from 1959-1963. He started the "Charter 25" program, which allowed students to begin medical training straight out of high school and become doctors in six rather than eight years. He directed this program and served as a full-time mentor to the

program participants from 1960-1968. From 1962-1969, he served on the editorial board for the AAMC's Journal of Medical Education, was a member of the Illinois Board of Public Health Advisors, and was part of the Illinois Legislative Commission on Atomic Energy.

Dr. Cooper became even more involved with the AAMC and medical education when in 1969 he was asked to become the first president of the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC), which up until then had been run by an Executive Director. Dr. Cooper helped bring the AAMC and its role in medical education to the forefront of the public's attention. In 1981, he was named by U.S. News and World Report as one of the five most influential people in medicine and health education. Dr. Cooper retired from his position as AAMC president in 1986.

He was also a writer and a scholar, and throughout his life and career as a physician, Dr. Cooper published more than 300 articles on biomedical research, medical education, health policy, and medical care in both scientific and professional journals. He was also the recipient of a number of honorary degrees, including a Doctor of Science Degree from Duke University and an honorary Doctor of Medical Science Degree at the Medical College of Pennsylvania. Additionally, he received the Health Services Award by the Charleston Area Medical Center in May 1973. Dr. Cooper died on January 27, 2002 at the age of 84 in Birmingham, Alabama.

**Scope, Content, and Arrangement:** The collection of materials from Dr. Cooper is arranged in eight series. The eight series are AAMC, Federal Government Organizations, Litigation, Memorabilia, Private Foundations, Private Organizations, Published Papers and Speeches. The Private Organizations, AAMC, and Federal Government Organizations series each contain sub-series of materials that relate to the larger theme, but do not contain enough material to be an individual series. All series and sub-series are arranged in alphabetical order and then chronologically within each sub series.

The AAMC files contain information regarding the communication between Dr. Cooper and the various divisions within the AAMC. The divisions included in the sub-series are AAMC Planning and Future Development, AMA Liaison, Continuing Medical Education, Liaison Committee for Graduate Medical Education, MCAT & Standardized Testing, and various AAMC Task Forces.

The Private Organizations files contain correspondence between Dr. Cooper and the following groups: Organization of University Health Center Administrators (OUHCA)/Association for Academic Health Centers (AAHC), the Education Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG), National Board of Medical Examiners (NBME), National Citizens Advisory Committee (NCAC), and the National Fund for Medical Education (NFME).

Dr. Cooper worked with numerous federal organizations during his tenure as AAMC president. These groups with which he corresponded were the Department of Health,

Education, and Welfare; Veterans Administration, and the White House & NIH and the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC) and Graduate Medical Education National Advisory Committee (GMENAC) are included in the Federal Government Organization series.

The Litigation series documents the legal correspondence and testimony in which Dr. Cooper participated as an advisor or as a witness. Copies of his various testimonies and the papers relating to the various cases are in this series.

As president of AAMC, Dr. Cooper gave numerous speeches. These speeches included those to formal gatherings such as the AAMC Annual Meeting, professional speeches to groups within the medical field, or commencement speeches at medical school graduations. Print versions of these speeches are arranged chronologically in the Speeches series.

Dr. Cooper served on the boards of a number of Private Foundations. This series contains correspondence between Dr. Cooper and the members of the various foundations in regards to meetings, decisions made within the committees, and recommendations from Dr. Cooper to members regarding appointments and other foundation matters.

As AAMC president, doctor, and professor of biochemistry, Dr. Cooper wrote and had many papers published in medical and scientific journals. This series contains copies of some of the papers he wrote during his tenure as AAMC president arranged chronologically.

Finally, the Memorabilia series contains a scrapbook of newspaper clippings of Dr. Cooper's activities at Northwestern and during his tenure at AAMC. There are two additional scrapbooks containing copies of Dr. Cooper's appointment and retirement letters. This series also contains photographs of Dr. Cooper, other members of the AAMC, and doctors who served with him on various committees.
